



Anuschka preferably should be grown on soils in good agricultural condition. Soils with high very high risk of spraing should be avoided. Production under fleece or foil, chitting or at least careful induction of sprouting before planting is recommended in order to accelerate maturity, skin set and harvest ability.

Anuschka is growing uniform medium to large sized tubers with a very nice skin finish. The tuberisation rate is medium, the recommended plant density is approx. 42,000 plants/ha.

Anuschka has a high resistance to second growth.

Anuschka is supplementing excellently the pre-packing assortment.
